



They fulfil the task successfully and return to the earth with a very sad Otho, because they had to leave his girl friend behind (alive - what did you think ?).


As Joan isn't participant of this journey, this is one of the shortest chapters of the love-story - sorry, folks.






German dialogue:

"But why has it always to be YOU ?!"


"Now see, I'm the super-hero here, so this is my task." (Abbreviated and VERY loose translation ©)


So the crew is ready for take-off and Joan waves good-bye.
